Lorenzo Quinn's Sculptures

The combination of that sentiment with the sense of touch would be a fraction of what a sculpture is. And what if it carries the name Lorenzo Quinn's? Yes, the son of the celebrated late actor (and artist) Anthony Quinn, and no, that isn't the reason why Lorenzo is the artist he is today.

Lorenzo Quinn was born in Rome in May 7<sup>th</sup> 1966. He studied art at the American Academy of Fine Arts in New York and had workshops and foundries both in the United States and Europe.

Other than having his work in many impressive private collections throughout the world, Lorenzo Quinn was also commissioned by the Vatican to sculpt a memorial to Saint Anthony, which now sits in the Basilica del Santo in Padua, and yes, the list is endless.

Other than his last exhibit in Dubai, Lorenzo's work has appeared worldwide. He frequently returns to Italy for inspiration where Ali Sebbagh caught up with him and stole a bit of his time to talk of art, family and the sound in his head that drives him.
